1. Apply on the internet and submit your application online. You will need to have an email address (not the student's email address), access to the internet and a printer.

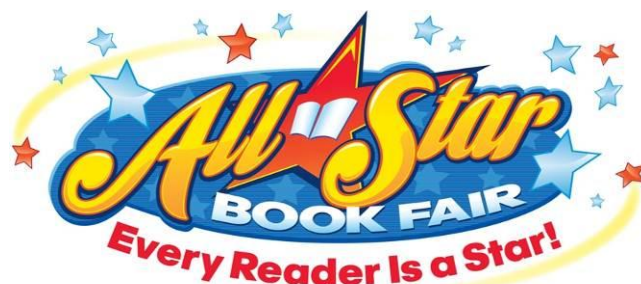
