Duties include:

Coordinate uniform donations

Hold a stall 3-5 times per year

Liaise with office personnel and be available for appointments

Collect and sort unnamed lost property for the stall

This position needs someone with strong interpersonal skills to work alongside school personnel and community members and ensure they understand the need of a high level of confidentiality.

5 safety tips for school zones

- 1 Allow enough time to get your child to the school gate safely and without rushing.
- 2 Always observe the parking signs outside the school. They are designed to keep children safe.
- 3 Never park illegally in a driveway on or near a school crossing, or in a bus bay.
- 4 Never double park. Double parking blocks the vision for other drivers, forcing children onto the road and obstructs the flow of traffic.
- 5 Park a few streets away and walk your children to school. This is also good for teaching your children road safety skills.

Always slow down to 40km/h

Set down your child on the school side of the road

Park only where parking is permitted, and

Never call out to your child from across the road

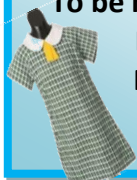

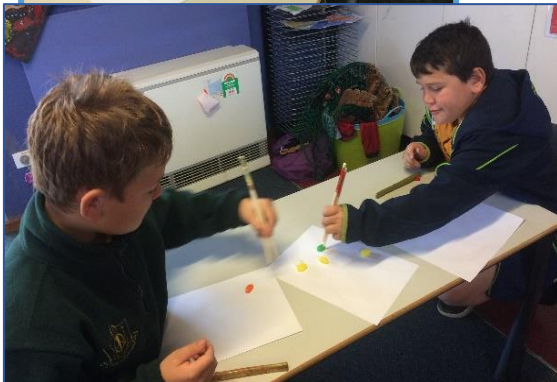
